AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION: Presentation, discussion and possible action for selection of end cap tile mosaic images for Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) to install at the FM 2818 / Villa Maria Bridge, which is currently under construction.			
SUMMARY STATEMENT: City Council workshop presentations and discussions have taken place on October 22, 2013, and November 18, 2013, regarding the options for the end cap tile mosaic images for TXDOT to install at the FM 2818 / Villa Maria Bridge. The November 18, 2013, City Council workshop meeting summarized the public input received and the selection committee's discussion and recommendation for the end cap images. The committee members were Art Hughes, Stephanie Sale Singleton, Greta Watkins and Panzie Johnson. The following three main themes were recommended from the committee: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Railroad Theme 2. Wildflower Theme 3. Local Theme <p>There are two (2) locations facing each direction (east/west) and would be 33 inch diameter circles with a 3/8 inch tile size limit to preserve image detail. Tight simple images work best. The broad hue range, yet limited color depth, of the Glass Tile palette demands colorful imagery for best results.</p> <p>The decision to go with one theme for all 4 images can be made or they can be mixed and matched between 2 or 3 of the themes.</p>			
STAFF ANALYSIS AND RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends utilizing the committee's recommendations in making the final selections. Council has the final selection for these images and TXDOT needs some direction before the end of December 2013, so a decision should be made at the December 10, 2013 meeting.
