<b>AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION:</b> Consider awarding the contract for 2014 Street Maintenance - Pavement Markings, City Project No. 332-D3-1406, to Pavement Markings, Inc., in the amount not to exceed \$108,550.20.			
<b>SUMMARY STATEMENT:</b> The 2014 Street Maintenance - Pavement Markings project consists of the removal of pavement markers and the restriping of pavement markings. Including approximately 102,000 linear feet of striping with additional associated pavement marking symbols.			
Streets to be striped include 28 <sup>th</sup> Street, 29 <sup>th</sup> Street, 32 <sup>nd</sup> Street, Brac Street, Broadmoor Drive, Brookside Drive, Cambridge Drive, Carson Street, Carter Creek Parkway, Cavitt Avenue, Copperfield Drive, Dodge Street, Eagle Pass, Freedom Boulevard, Joseph Drive, Meadow Lane, Nuches Drive, Oak Street, Old College Road, Sims Avenue, Tanglewood Drive, Villa Maria Road, Finfeather Road, Oak Ridge Drive and Barak Lane. The contract includes both thermoplastic striping for more permanent markings as well as paint markings, which cost less, being placed where markings are currently needed but additional pavement improvements will occur in a couple of years.			
Bids for this contract were opened on June 17, 2014, and of the four (4) bids received. Pavement Markings, Inc., was the lowest bidder at \$108,550.20. The bids ranged from \$108,550.20 to \$166,644.84.			
<b>STAFF ANALYSIS AND RECOMMENDATION:</b> Awarding the contract will allow for the renewal of the pavement traffic control. Awarding the contract will expend transportation fee funds. Staff recommends awarding the contract to Pavement Markings, Inc., in an amount of \$108,550.20.
