Please place the following item on the Bryan City Council Regular Agenda for the August 12, 2014 meeting:

Discussion, consideration and possible action to direct the City Staff

1. to investigate and report the feasibility and cost to use vacant land (map enclosed) currently owned by the City of Bryan in the following locations:
 - a. Mumford Rd approximately 300 acres
 - b. Bryan Municipal Lake approximately 800 acres
 - c. Bryan Regional Athletic Complex approximately 60 acres
 - d. Other city owned locations if time permitsfor the use as a Regional Park with full facilities and/or Blinn College. Report the findings including associated costs to the City Council at the regularly scheduled second meeting of September 2014.

2. to review the skate park project and report the findings on the issues below to the City Council at the regularly scheduled second meeting of September 2014:
 - a. the population and location of skate boarders (the number of users)
 - b. the total cost per skating facility by size, include toilet facilities, parking, lighting and observer accommodations
 - c. identify suitable locations in Sadie Thomas Park, Henderson Park, Bonham Park and the City owned 28 acres in Austin Colony at Mitchell Elementary School.

3. delete Park Hudson from any consideration as a location for a skate board park.






Lake Bryan Property
