
Discussion consideration and possible action to direct the city staff to add a project to the current year's budget for procurement of land, design, construction and funding that adds as many parking places to Scurry Park in the available surrounding property.

Description: Scurry is the oldest park in Bryan and is heavily used by area residents. It is 6.5 acres and has restrooms, picnic tables, a playground, lighted basketball court, baseball field, softball field and other amenities. However, some of the very few parking spaces have been lost for public use. Many more spaces are needed to meet the usage demands of the park. Land is available surrounding the park to add more spaces. A property owner has agreed to sell land at a reasonable cost, one land owner has agreed to donate land and the City has unused land in the area.
