AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION: Consideration and possible action to approve the final 2014 tax roll as submitted by the Brazos County Tax Assessor-Collector. State law requires City Council approval of the final tax roll.			
SUMMARY STATEMENT: Brazos County Tax Assessor-Collector Kristeen Roe has provided the tax rolls for approval. Section 26.09 (e) of the Tax Code requires a taxing entity's governing body to accept the tax roll as prepared by the Tax Assessor-Collector. The tax roll submitted for approval includes four (4) supplemental value changes and one (1) ownership change file. The resulting levy is decreased \$7,654.29 from the original 2014 tax year value certifications: the FY2015 budgeted "Total Tax Levy" changes from \$26,968,962 to \$26,961,307.71.			
This final tax roll serves as the basis for the billings prepared by the tax office.			
STAFF ANALYSIS AND RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the City of Bryan City Council approve the tax rolls as submitted by the Brazos County Tax Assessor-Collector. This approval is in compliance with the Texas Property Tax Code.
