The City Manager or his representative shall provide an update on the Bryan Police Department in the following areas:


1. Status report on body cameras for Police Officers and any other equipment needed for officer safety
2. Department efforts to recruit minority police officers
3. Department training and operational procedures to handle situations similar to the Ferguson, MO shooting incident
4. Department training and operational procedures to handle riots
5. Department training and operational procedures to deal with terrorist activities
6. Discipline policy for police officers

Discussion: The Police Officers are the key city employees in the protection and safety of the citizens of Bryan. For their own protection and to provide the public protection for their lives, property and freedoms, they must have the best equipment, training, and operational procedures the City can afford to provide them.
