Perform a traffic study and analysis on the traffic in and around Blinn College and that traffic anticipated with the location of a YMCA at the 29<sup>th</sup> and Villa Maria campus (see attachment). The study should show the amount of congestion experienced currently and that traffic congestion added with a YMCA located on campus. Since the YMCA project is moving relatively fast, the results of the traffic study and analysis should be presented to the Council no later than June 2016.
