Summary Statement *	<p>This Council Action Form is a request for the Mayor to execute an Interlocal Agreement between Brazos County, the City of College Station, and the City of Bryan for the purpose of applying for a joint formula grant through the U.S. Department of Justice under the 2016 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program in the amount of \$55,379.00.</p> <p>The grant funds will be disbursed between the participating entities in the following manner: City of Bryan receiving \$22,933.00, Brazos County receiving \$8,306.85, and the City of College Station receiving \$24,139.15. The City of Bryan Police Department intends to use its portion of the grant (\$22,933.00) for purposes such as supporting local initiatives, technical assistance, training, personnel, equipment, supplies, contractual support, information technology, research, and evaluation activities that will improve or enhance law enforcement programs.</p> <p>By approving this agreement, the City Council is providing authorization for the City staff to submit financial and/or status reports as necessary and other reporting documents to the Bureau of Justice Assistance as required to comply with the grant terms.</p>
Staff Analysis & Recommendation *	<p>The Edward Byrne JAG program provides law enforcement agencies funding for technology enhancements and equipment purchases. City staff will be required to submit financial status reports and supporting documentation to the Bureau of Justice Assistance to comply with grant terms.</p> <p>The Bryan Police Department recommends approving and executing the Interlocal Agreement between Brazos County, the City of College Station, and the City of Bryan for the 2016 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant to support the purchase of law enforcement equipment and technology. The Edward Byrne JAG Program does not require matching funds.</p>
