**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRYAN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BRYAN FIRE DEPARTMENT TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION FOR MOBILE COMMAND VEHICLE UPGRADES AND SATELLITE SERVICE TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR; PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE AND COMPLIANCE WITH THE TEXAS OPEN MEETINGS ACT.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bryan, Texas (“City”) is a home rule municipality which is duly incorporated and chartered under the constitution and laws of Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Bryan finds it is in the best interests of the citizens of Bryan, Texas, that the city obtains upgrades for the Mobile Command Vehicle and annual subscription to satellite service; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council approves of the City of Bryan Fire Department submitting a grant application to the Office of the Governor for the State of Texas to obtain funds to obtain such upgrades and service; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council agrees that in the event of the loss or misuse of the funds from the Office of the Governor, the City Council assures that the funds shall be repaid in full; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council designates the Mayor of the City of Bryan, as the City’s authorized official in regards to this grant application and delegates authority to the Mayor to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the City;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRYAN, TEXAS:**

1.

The recitals are hereby adopted as if fully set forth herein for all purposes.

2.

The City Council hereby appoints the Mayor as the authorized official for the City in regards to grant number 2958002, a grant application to the Office of the Governor for funds for upgrades to the City’s Mobile Command Vehicle, and annual subscription for Satellite Service for the year 2017. The City Council further approves and authorizes the Mayor to submit such application to the Office of the Governor.

3.

This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption, but shall in no way effect the validity of prior acts or agreements of the City.

This document was passed and approved at a public meeting in compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act.
