Agenda Item Description*	Consider approving a contract to permit Pronto Services to conduct a commercial roll-off container operation, collecting non-residential properties, construction, demolition, and special cleanup sites within the City of Bryan.
Summary Statement*	<p>The City Charter and Solid Waste Ordinance prohibit the private collection of wastes unless otherwise permitted by the City. Furthermore, by ordinance, only the City shall be the municipal solid waste collection provider for residents. Permits are required for commercial collection by private waste haulers as the City of Bryan is considered a "closed city". Permits can only be obtained for materials not collected by the City or where the City cannot provide adequate container size (e.g. roll off containers or compactors).</p> <p>Pronto Services is seeking to obtain a permit to allow them to haul solid waste materials from desired locations within the City with roll-off containers. Their roll-offs range from 20 to 40-yard containers. Pronto Services intends to haul building debris such as plywood, sheet rock, brick, and lumber along with other commercial solid waste from approved locations throughout the city. The company will dispose all waste materials and debris at the BVSWMA landfill.</p> <p>Currently, the City of Bryan has two similar permitted "roll-off" waste haulers. The two permitted waste haulers (Brazos Valley Recycling and Texas Commercial Waste) are permitted to collect solid waste such as garbage, trash, recyclable material, brush, and other refuse from approved sites.</p> <p>In accordance to the permit, Pronto Services is required to pay quarterly fees to the City of \$500 per vehicle or 6% of gross hauling revenues, whichever of the two amounts is greater. The approval of Pronto Services' permit will provide options for citizens when requiring services not offered or are greater than the City can provide.</p>
Staff Analysis & Recommendation*	Environmental Services respectfully requests the City Council consider the agreement to permit Pronto Services to collect non-residential properties, construction, demolition, and special cleanup sites within the City of Bryan. Permitting an additional waste hauler will allow the citizens and businesses another option when it comes to the collection of construction and commercial waste.
