Agenda Item Description* Consider approving an extension with Conner's Crushed Stone for Type A/Grade 1 flexible base material in a not to exceed amount of \$196,300.

Summary Statement* Five (5) sealed bids for the Annual Price Agreement for Type A/Grade 1 Crushed Rock Flexible Base were received and opened on June 15, 2015. The bid providing the best value to the City was the lowest bid submitted by Conner's Crushed Stone in the amount of \$196,300. This agreement has a provision, which if both parties agree, can be extended up to four (4) times for a total of five (5) years. As stated in the extension letter attached, both parties are in agreement to extend this price agreement.

Over the past three contract years, Streets & Drainage has spent \$102,314; \$81,933; and \$90,784 of the then not to exceed amount of \$199,000. Currently, we have spent \$79,163 of the not to exceed amount of \$196,300.

Flexible Base material is essential for the Public Works street maintenance program. Flex base is a multi-purpose material used to repair utility cuts, base failures, and to provide the flexible foundation that supports the asphalt surface of city streets. The Streets & Drainage Department requests the City Council approve the first of four possible one-year extensions of this contract with Conner's Crushed Stone.

Staff Analysis & Recommendation* The Streets & Drainage Department respectfully requests the City Council approve this first one-year extension with Conner's Crushed Stone. Approving this extension assures the City has a readily available source of high quality base materials for use on water, wastewater, and street maintenance repairs. If this contract is not approved, the repair of waterlines and streets, as a result of maintenance, will have to find an alternative material for backfill.

2. Do not approve the extension and re-bid
