

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2146; INCREASING EXPENDITURE APPROPRIATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016 FROM \$404,717,209 to \$405,207,542; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETINGS AT WHICH THE ORDINANCE IS PASSED ARE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, state law requires that municipal budget appropriations be increased when spending exceeds the amount appropriated, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bryan wishes to increase appropriations to facilitate the payment of contractual obligations which were not included in the Fiscal Year 2016 budget upon adoption,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRYAN, TEXAS:

1.

That the City of Bryan City Council approves increases in appropriations in the amount of \$490,333.

2.

That Ordinance No. 2146, the appropriations ordinance for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2015 and ending September 30, 2016, be amended to reflect total expenditures for the City of Bryan be increased from \$404,717,209 to \$405,207,542.

3.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

4.

That should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

5.

That it is hereby found and determined that the meetings at which this ordinance was passed were open to the public, as required by Section 551.001 et seq., Texas Government Code, and that advance public notice of time, place and purpose of said meetings was given.

6.

That this ordinance shall take effect immediately after its second and final reading.
